

### The School



U.S. News & World Report awarded Stone Memorial the Silver Award among the nation's best high schools. The academic program is organized on a block schedule, where the maximum load is 9 credits per year. Our high school has gained accreditation from the Tennessee State Board of Education and the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.
